Legal Requirements

There are 2 main regulations that have to be adhered to in order for lifting equipment to be deemed safe – these are MANDATORY requirements of any employer that provides a MEWP (or any lifting equipment) for use at work.

- 1. LOLER 98 - The Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (LOLER 98)**
(this is what we generally call the inspection – LOLER certification)
- 2. PUWER 98 - The Provision & Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER 98)**

Basically together they require equipment to be:

- Safe for use and suitable for the conditions being worked in
- Maintained in a safe condition, so the operatives health is not at risk
- Inspected at **regular intervals** by a competent person – thoroughly examined on a **6 monthly basis** and records kept
